Announcements

Reports:

- Jim, Girls' Basketball – We built the schedule from the online system. There's a lot of mutual respect with the Middle School Phys. Ed. Teachers. We'll move out of the Elementary School – it's too small – and squeeze into the Middle School. The transition to Stacey Wednick is going well.
- Andy, Baseball – Online registration begins in March.
- Brian & Chuck, Boys' Basketball – Can Sacred Heart's teams stop 10 min before the hour? Who is in the school before 4pm Sundays? What about other times? Some leaders are enforcing the rules (e.g. no food or drink) but it isn't consistent. Should we be doing it? No. There's an issue with the remote to get the baskets up and down.

- Nancy, Summer Tots – Online registration begins around 2/18; there's a budget proposed and approved via email, and a requested-facility-issue which has been resolved.
- Dominic, Girls' Softball – Walk-in registration has ended; registration is up. The online system was screwed up – is that fixed yet? They plan a tournament this year.
- Kathy & Nicole, Ballet – session is starting now; registration ends next week. They are working on Peter Pan and a 3/28 Epcot performance. They are expanding – Toni Amos is the new Assistant Director and Djuana Tawanas is the new Treasurer. They are working with the custodian at the Middle School but everything is fine at the High School.
