REISTERSTOWN SUMMER PLAYGROUND & EXTENDED CAMP REGISTRATION

Welcome to the 2010 season of the Reisterstown Summer Playground!

As of January 1, 2010 registration is open for all participants.

There is a early payment and sibling discount for payments postmarked by May 31, 2010.

On May 31, 2010, all unpaid balances will revert to the regular program rate of \$125.00 per participant per week.

Before & Aftercare is available as listed below at a cost of \$30.00 per child per week.

There will be **NO walk-in registration.**

Please fill out the both pages of a separate registration form completely for each child. Be sure to provide the information for a person to contact in case of an emergency if you are unavailable as well as your child's physician's name and number. **Applications without this information will be returned.** On the reverse, please check all trips on which you will permit your child to go. **Please read and initial each item of the "IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS" section as well as read the LATE PICK-UP POLICY.** When you have completed the information portion of the application, please check the box before each week for which you wish to sign up your child.

To receive an initial discount, sign and date and return the registration form with your NON-REFUNDABLE payment for at least one week's fees BEFORE May 31, 2010. To continue to receive the discount, pay your balance in full before May 31, 2010. Any unpaid balance remaining after that date will revert to the regular program rate of \$125.00 per child per week. Minimum accepted payment at any time is one week's fee. **Please make checks payable to : RRC - PLAYGROUND** and mail with the application to the address at the bottom of page two of the application form.

2010 REISTERSTOWN SUMMER PLAYGROUND & EXTENDED CAMP POLICY - PARENTS' COPY

Program Description: This program is operated as a traditional summer playground. It is permitted for a child to walk to and from the site with the parent's permission. It is also acceptable if a parent does not want their child to leave the site during operating hours. In either case, please make your wishes known to your child & your child's camp site leader. Field trip admission & bus fare is included in registration fee. There is no other transportation provided. There are no sign-in or sign-out procedures.

A schedule of activities will be provided each week. A variety of age-appropriate indoor and outdoor activities will be scheduled every day including arts & crafts, quiet & active games and sports. Each child is encouraged but not required to participate in every activity. Activities will be adjusted for weather extremes (heat/rain) but the program will not close. Every child should bring lunch and a drink. There is no refrigeration available for lunches. Sodas and candy will be available for sale during/after lunch.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENT(S) OF SUMMER PROGRAM PARTICIPANT(S)

I understand this program is designed to provide a healthy and enjoyable leisure experience for my child(ren). However I also understand that this program is not designed to provide child care. Therefore, I understand it is my responsibility to discuss attendance expectations with my child(ren) and with their campsites leader. **Recreation staff cannot detain youth wishing to leave at any time. It is for this reason that we cannot impose participant sign-in or sign-out.**

I understand that the playground program operates Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM to 4:45 PM. **NO CHILD IS TO BE DROPPED OFF AT SITE BEFORE 9:00 AM unless enrolled in the extended care program.** The parent of any child left at the site after 5:00 PM will be subject to the fees and sanctions explained below in the **LATE PICK-UP POLICY.**

I understand the playground program begins on Monday, June 28, 2010 and ends on Thursday, August 5, 2010. Playground is closed Monday, 7/5 and Friday, 8/6. Extended camp runs from Monday, August 9 through August, 20 at the Reisterstown Regional Park.

I understand the playground site will be closed during the time a field trip is taking place. No one will be at the site to supervise any children that may arrive after the buses leave for the planned trip.

LATE PICK-UP POLICY

- (1) Organized activities end at 4:15 PM and camp is closed at 4:45 PM except for extended-hour participants.
- (2) In you encounter an **emergency**, please call the *playground office* (not the rec office) to let us know.
- (3) Unless aftercare is registered and paid for, at **5:00 PM**, a late fee of **\$10.00 per child*** will be assessed. For every minute late after 5:00 PM, an additional **\$1.00 per child*** will be charged. Lateness will be determined according to the clock in the playground office and the program director will have the final word on ALL disputes. The Franklin Police Station will be notified to collect any child left at the site after **5:30 PM. All monies for late pick-up fees are payable in cash before the child(ren) may again be allowed on the site.**
- (4) If late pick-up occurs more than **once***, the child(ren) will be exited from the program and all fees will be forfeit.

Playground staff does not get paid for hours beyond the operation of the program (9:00 AM to 4:45 PM). They have family obligations and other engagements before and after camp. Waiting for children to be picked up after camp hours impedes them from fulfilling these other obligations. Please help the camp to run smoothly by adhering to the 4:45 PM pick-up time.

* **Please note:** Should car pooling result in a late pick-up, the parents of **all** children involved will be subject to late fees and sanctions as listed in items 3, 4, and 5 of this section. Please take this into consideration if you should decide to make such arrangements for your child(ren).
