We have 6 age divisions available, 4-6 (PEEWEE), 7-8 (CLINIC), 9-10 (MINORS), 11-12 (MAJORS), 13-15 (PONY), AND 15-17 (STALLION). The PEEWEE and CLINIC leagues are non-competitive teaching divisions. Practice and games begin on April 1, 2010 and continue through the end of the Balto. Co. school year. **Age determination** is your child's age on July 31, 2010. For example, if your child is age 8 on July 31, 2010, he will play in the Clinic league. PEEWEE games are played on Saturdays. CLINIC through PONY play during the week. The STALLION division will be an in-house program for young men and will be played on 90' diamonds. Please note that the league starts later than the younger levels. We also offer TRAVEL BASEBALL in five age divisions for more competitive play on the weekends. This year we will offer programs for 8-17 yr. olds. Early registration (until 2/28/10) fees* are as follows: Clinic (7,8) \$90.00, Minors (9,10) \$95.00, Majors (11,12) \$100.00, Ponys (13,14) \$110.00, Stallion (15-17) \$120.00, PeeWees (4-6) \$75.00. After 2/28/10, a late fee will be assessed to registrations for all age groups. *Please note: Pee Wee and AAU players are not considered in the discount because of the nature of their respective programs. 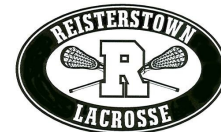
Reisterstown Elementary School at 223 Walgrove Rd. for ages 6-12 M-F starting June 28 through August 5 (tentative) from 9a to 4:45p for \$90 per child per week (\$85/2nd child, \$80/additional child from same immediate family). Extended hours available 8a-9a and 4:45-5:30p for \$30 per child per week. Also 2 weeks Extended Camp for the same days, hours & cost from August 9-20 at Reisterstown Regional Park.

Early mail-in registration for the 2010 season will begin January 1 and run through the end of May. If paid in full before 5/31/10, this program is offered for a total of eight weeks at a discounted cost of **\$90.00 week** (discounts available for additional **immediate** family members).

All unpaid program fees will revert to the regular program cost of \$125.00 per week for all participants (no family discounts) after 5/31/10. Cost includes the bus and admission costs for any field trips. Trips are planned to Oregon Ridge Park, Cascade Lake and Magic Elm Skateland. A variety of activities is planned and a schedule for each week is provided. Online registration & payment may be available for those desiring to pay in full after the first of the year. Otherwise, applications and a program description will be available on council website soon.

About Our Program

The **registration cost is \$125.00** per participant. It is our hope that we can accept every child, but there may be situations where registrations exceed the practical number of players allowed per team. In this instance, priority will be given to those who have played the previous year in our program, and those living in areas served directly by the Reisterstown & Owings Mills Rec. Councils. We do not deposit checks until we know space will be available for your child.

Outdoor practices begin March 1. Some age groups may have indoor evaluations/tryouts in January & February. Parents will be notified if this pertains to your child. League games begin approx. the first weekend in April and continue thru the end of May. This is a *travel league* for all ages, with weekend and weeknight games all around the Baltimore Metro area and requires a commitment to attend practices and games. *Players must provide all necessary equipment.*

***NOTE:** Age eligible 9th graders can play rec only if they do not play on a high school team.

REC & PARKS INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY:

Weekdays - If school are closed by snow, ice or other severe weather conditions all day or before the regular dismissal time, all activities (programs & meetings) scheduled for that afternoon or evening would be cancelled.

Weekends/School holidays - In the event of any significant accumulation of snow and/or ice when school is not in session, recreation programs will be cancelled whenever the snow emergency plan is in effect. When the snow emergency plan is lifted, school parking lots & sidewalks are clear & safe, a BCPS representative from the Office of Operations will contact the Recreation Services to authorize the resumption of recreation activity.

Extended Closings - If school are closed for longer than 3 days and the snow emergency plan has been lifted, a BCPS representative from the Office of Operations will contact Recreation Services to discuss the resumption of activities as school parking lots & sidewalks become clear & safe. Recreation services will then contact local staff.

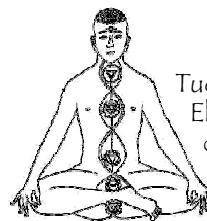
